Personal Requests

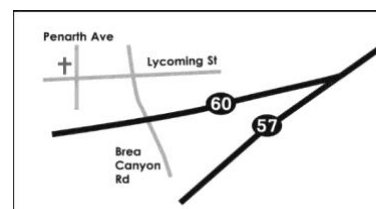
