- 20% of Americans attend church every week vs. 35% in 2020. The highest in America history was in the 1950's at 57%.(Gallup)
- 30% of Americans attend church once per month. [Gallup]
- 57% of Americans are seldom or never in religious service attendance vs. 35% in 2020 (Gallup)
- Post-Pandemic, one out of four church members never came back, 25%.

How many people leave the church each day?

Post-pandemic, approximately 5,000 people left the religious congregations every day. That is a rate of 1.8 million walking away from church every year. While each church is unique, leading experts say a church should expect to lose about 10%-15% of its members year over year.

- 16% of Christians who attended church pre-pandemic have stopped attending entirely (Barna)
- In 2022, 4,500 churches closed in America. That number could double by 2026.
- One recent survey asked why people are leaving the church, and the number one answer is: Church members seem to be judgmental or hypocritical. In other words, the church is perceived as inauthentic.

- Nondenominational churches are seeing noticeable growth, with 6.5 million more people attending a nondenominational church in 2020 than in 2010 (US Religion Census)
- Since 2015, 8000 churches chose to unaffiliate and become non-denominational, and another 10,000 considering the switch over a 10-year period.

- Millennials (81-96) are the largest group leaving denominational churches. Main reason: They're turned off by the high-profile church leadership scandals and the increasing political polarization in so many denomination congregations, causing many to lose trust in churches and religious institutions all together.
- Millennials are also the largest growth demographics in non-denominational churches.

There are 3 primary reasons why we are seeing a shift in church attendance. Why?

- 1. Apathy a lack of interest, enthusiasm, or concern.
- 2. Consumerism a culture shift
- 3. Competition the growth of podcasts and streaming

The number of US podcast listeners have increased year over year since 2013, reaching an estimated 164 million (U.S. Population 340 million)
